TRYING TO HIDE FROM GOD!

One day, Jesus Christ will judge the entire world. Nothing will escape His faculties. He knows all and sees all. One cannot hide from God. Adam and Eve tried to hide from God but could not. Elijah ran far away and hid in a remote cave in the wilderness of Sinai but could never escape God. It is awesome to realize that God sees us all the time. It's comforting to know that He sees the evil actions of others against us. However, no matter how one commits sin, one cannot hide from God. God will discover it. Notice several examples.

One may sin in secret like the sin of Cain (Gen. 4:8-10). Cain killed his only brother in the field because of jealousy. However, he brought it upon himself because his sacrifice was not pleasing to God (Gen. 4:5; Heb. 11:4). Notice the powerful statement from God prior to this ghastly murder: "If thou doest well, shalt thou not be accepted? And if thou doest not well, sin lieth at the door." (Gen. 4:7) It does not matter if one commits sin in secret, because God will discover it.

One may commit sin years before its discovery like the sin of Joseph's brothers (Gen 42:21). Jacob had thought for many years that his son, Joseph, was dead. In fact, when his sons came with the good news, he did not even believe them at first (Gen. 45:26). Although many think that time will remove sin from one's life, time is not a factor with God in the realm of sin.

One may well cover up sin like the sin of Achan (Josh. 7:21). In his explanation to Joshua. Achan mentioned that he hid the coveted items "in the earth in the midst of his tent, and the silver under it." He thought he would get away with it. Did not David do the same thing with Bathsheba? Did he not try to cover his sin by having Uriah killed? David later confessed that he committed sin against God "in thy sight" (Psa. 51:4). One cannot hide his sins from God, no matter how well one covers it up!

Others may prompt one to sin like the sin of Ahab (I Kings 21:7). When Ahab openly coveted Naboth's vineyard, his wife Jezebel schemed to have Naboth put to death. In Elijah's confrontation with Ahab, he said, "Thou hast sold thyself to work evil in the sight of the Lord" (I Kings 21:20). The Bible records repeatedly the sin of bad companionship. Worldly peers constantly tempt young people to partake in evil deeds. God will bring all such sins into judgment.

One may commit sin in ignorance like the sins of the Jews (Luke 23:34). Their ignorance did not excuse them from their sin. Peter confronted them with their sin, and told them to repent (Acts 2:23, 36-38). God forgave those who repented and were baptized from their sin; God did not forgive those who refused. A constant study of God's word will help our knowledge of His will to convict the sins of which we're ignorant. (Rom.7:7).

Moses said, "Be sure your sin will find you out" (Num. 32:23). As the song is sung, "There is an all-seeing eye watching you!" Sinner, please repent – don't try to hide from God!
